### I. Activities Related to Goals

- The Parent Involvement Committee has created a survey which will be going out to the community on March 16<sup>th</sup>. The completed surveys are due back by April 15<sup>th</sup>. After that time, we will collate the data and determine what activities the committee should undertake for next year.
- The Literacy Committee has been meeting all year to create an intervention manual to share with the staff. Under the direction of Kelli Killion, that manual is almost set to go.
- The playground committee has launched a calendar raffle to begin raising funds. There are also lots of small prizes which have come in which will be used for a prize raffle to be held in May and sold by the students. We still have not heard from the Land and Water Conservation Fund Grant or the Lowe's Grant. Jude met with some town representatives concerning a trust fund which could possibly contribute to the playground. More information is being gathered before they can make a decision.
- CWES and WMS are working together to create alternative professional development activities to replace the Common Day Workshop which had been scheduled for March 10. Make-up activities will be offered after school and possibly on a Saturday as well.
